NATIONAL ALLIANCE FOR CARE AT HOME ANNOUNCES MAJOR LEADERSHIP CHANGE AS IT NAMES NEW CEO

The National Alliance for Care at Home has announced a leadership transition as foundational CEO Dr. Steve Landers steps down after guiding the organization through its formative phase. Landers, who led the Alliance from its launch following the merger of the National Association for Home Care & Hospice and the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization, will leave his post effective February 9, 2026. Jennifer Sheets will assume the role on February 17, 2026. In addition to becoming CEO, Sheets will take on the presidency of the Research Institute for Home Care, which is affiliated with the Alliance.

Sheets brings nearly 25 years of experience across the healthcare continuum, including roles as Founder and CEO of Carezzi and as President and CEO of both Caring Brands International and Interim HealthCare Inc. Her background spans ICU nursing, hospital leadership, home health, hospice, and healthcare technology, along with executive positions at major organizations such as BAYADA Home Health Care and Gentiva Healthcare. She has also been active in national industry boards and advocacy efforts in Washington, D.C., and has received recognitions like the 2023 American Business Awards Woman of the Year in Consumer Services.

The Board of Directors highlighted Landers’s contributions in establishing the Alliance as a unified voice for care-at-home providers and expressed confidence in Sheets’s ability to build on that foundation. Her deep familiarity with the Alliance’s strategic direction, combined with her broad industry expertise, positions her to lead the organization into its next chapter of growth and impact.

As the Alliance continues to advocate for policies supporting home care, home health, palliative, and hospice services, the transition is framed as a continuity of mission with an eye toward expanding access and influence across the care-at-home sector. Landers will remain involved through the transition period to ensure a smooth handoff and uphold the organization’s ongoing advocacy, member services, and strategic efforts.
